Kyobo Life Travel Scholarship

With the financial support from Kyobo Life Insurance Company limited travel aid will be provided to selected junior authors. To be eligible for consideration, you should be a Ph.D. candidate or a junior professor with less than three years of academic experience. The qualified author may apply for the support by submitting his or her resume at the time of proposal submission.

The Kyobo Life Travel Scholarship is valued US\$500 and covers the conference registration fee.

Yu Ziyou Memorial Scholarship

With the Yu Ziyou Memorial Scholarship limited travel aid will be provided to selected junior authors residing in developing economies. To be eligible for consideration, you should be a Ph.D. candidate or a junior professor with less than three years of academic experience. The qualified author may apply for the support by submitting his or her resume at the time of proposal submission.

Receiving this award is contingent to winning the Kyobo Life Travel Scholarship.

The Yu Ziyou Memorial Scholarship is valued US\$500.

Harold D Skipper Award for the Best Paper

The committee selects the best paper from the pool of full papers submitted to the conference.

The Harold D Skipper Award is valued US\$1,000.

School of Risk Management's Award for Best Asia-Pacific Journal of Risk and Insurance (APJRI) Paper

The journal Editorial Board selects the best paper(s) published in the year before the conference.

The School of Risk Management's Award for Best AP JRI paper is valued US\$1,000 per year for 10 years. Access to the prize money is contingent to conference attendance for presentation of the paper.

APRIA-Kyobo Life Contribution Award

The Executive Committee awards this prize for outstanding contributions to APRIA.

The APRIA-Kyobo Life Contribution Award is valued US\$2,000.
