

Awards for Junior Scholars from Developing Economies

World Risk and Insurance Economics Congress (WRIEC) 2015

August 2-6, 2015

Munich, Germany

Following the tradition from previous WRIECs, we will provide limited financial aid to selected junior authors from developing economies whose papers are accepted for the program. Platinum and gold sponsors of the 3rd World Congress have made available these awards. The number and amount of awards will depend on the funds available.

To be eligible for consideration, you should currently be a doctoral degree candidate or within three years from having received a doctoral degree. Furthermore, your institution should be located in a developing economy and you should receive no financial support from your university, government, or other entity for the attendance of the 3rd World Congress. The award assists the recipients with meeting the conference registration fee (excluding the membership fee to their respective association) and the payment for their accommodation expenses on a two-person-sharing basis for five nights at a reasonably priced hotel near the conference venue. The award does not cover travel and other expenses.

The applicant for the aid must indicate his or her desire to apply for the award when submitting the paper. The deadline for paper submission is **February 2nd, 2015**. You will be asked to provide a CV during the submission process. Notifications will be sent out soon after the final decisions about paper acceptance.
